

## **COVID-19 INFORMATION**

**Summer School:** Update provided by the Governor's Office on Friday, June 5: Gov. Andrew Cuomo has issued an [executive order](#) that permits schools to teach special education in person this summer.

*The order reads: "Notwithstanding any prior executive order to the contrary, special education services, and instruction required under federal, state or local laws, rules, or regulations, may be provided in person for the summer term in school districts. Any district providing such services in person must follow state and federal guidance."*

On Friday, May 1, Governor Cuomo announced that schools will be closed for the remainder of this academic year and a decision regarding summer school is expected at the end of May. In response to this announcement, our district is developing an end-of-year plan that will highlight school graduation, the return of District Chromebooks and textbooks, plans for summer school, and so much more; as well as a recovery plan in preparation for the 2020-2021 school year. We will continue to share information as we receive it.

**Meals:** We continue to deliver breakfast and lunch to children aged 18 or under residing in the Millbrook Central School District and Saturday and Sunday meals have been added to our Friday deliveries.
